PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

Do you know the laws and regulations about parking recreational equipment on town streets? How about the laws and regulations governing parking of vehicles or trailers with expired registration?

Town ordinance 11.16.050 states: <u>Parking, storage, or use of major recreational equipment</u>. For purposes of these regulations, major recreational equipment is defined as including boats and boat trailers, travel trailers, pickup campers, or coaches (designed to be mounted on automobile vehicles), motorized dwellings, tent trailers and the like, and cases or boxes used for transporting recreational equipment, whether occupied by such equipment or not.

No major recreational equipment may be parked or stored within 16 feet of the curb on a front lot or within 15 feet from the curb on a corner lot on side, except temporarily for visiting guests and then not to exceed 60 consecutive days.

Ordinance 11.16.060 states: <u>Parking and storage of certain vehicles</u>. Automotive vehicles or trailers of any kind or type without current license plates shall not be parked or stored on any residentially zoned property other than off-street parking space.

The town is asking for the public's help in cleaning up our streets. This will help during the chip seal project and make plowing snow during the winter months easier for our public works department.
